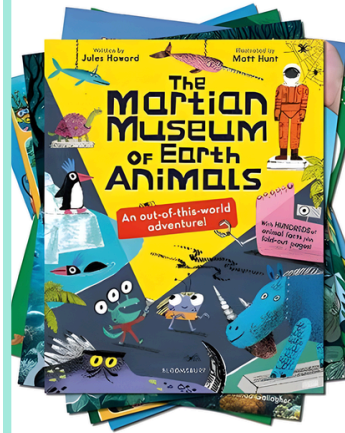

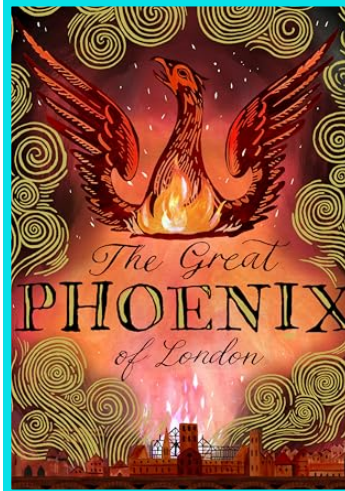

The Great Phoenix of London:
Lindsay Galvin

Children build **comprehension, vocabulary, and writing skills through guided reading, discussion, and creative tasks.** We explore character, setting, and historical context while developing confidence in both spoken and written English.

Explore the textures of the natural world through **drawing, collage, and mixed media.** Children experiment with materials, layering, and mark-making while developing observation and creative skills. Inspired by artists and nature, we build confidence in planning and creating imaginative, textured artworks.

Explore powerful stories of people who challenged unfair systems and changed history. Students build **historical understanding, critical thinking, and empathy through discussion, timelines, and creative tasks.** We focus on leadership, justice, and the impact of standing up for what is right.

Explore how cities can become greener, smarter, and fairer for the future. Learners build **geographical understanding** through maps, case studies, discussion, and creative tasks as they investigate transport, energy, waste, and urban design. **We focus on problem-solving, environmental awareness, and imagining better places to live.**

History

The Stuarts: A Dramatic Time in British History

Step into a turbulent period of kings, conflict, and change. Learners explore the Stuart era through key events like the English Civil War, the execution of a king, and the Great Fire of London. Through timelines, sources and discussion we build historical understanding, enquiry skills, and confidence in exploring cause and consequence.

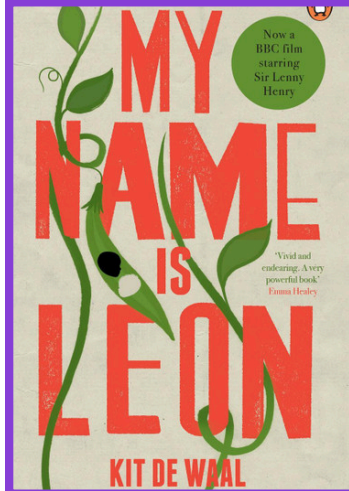

My Name is Leon Kit de Waal

Explore this powerful story of Leon, a young boy navigating family separation and life in the care system. Students build comprehension and analytical skills while exploring character, themes, and social context through discussion and written responses.



Creative Writing

Unlock your imagination through weekly writing challenges that explore **character, setting, description and dialogue**. Learners **build confident writing voices, stronger vocabulary and storytelling skills** as they experiment with different genres—from suspense to fantasy to real-world drama. A supportive space to create, share ideas and develop crafty, compelling writing.



Art

Stacked Stories

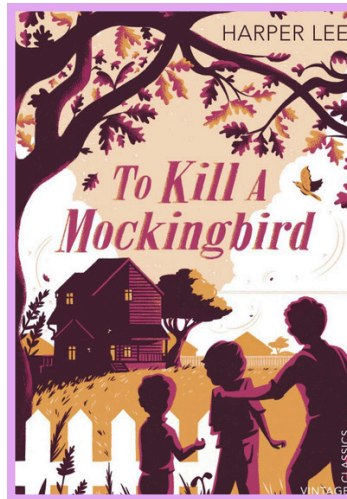
Create bold **3D artworks** that tell a story through stacked forms and symbols. Students **develop drawing, design, and sculpture skills** as they transform ideas into layered pieces inspired by totem-style storytelling. We focus on structure, meaning, and using materials to communicate identity and narrative.



KS4/GCSE Ages 14-16

English To Kill a Mockingbird Harper Lee

Study this powerful novel set in the American South, exploring themes of justice, prejudice, and morality. Students develop analytical, essay writing, and exam skills through close reading, discussion, and exploring character, context, and key ideas.



Art Layers of Me

Explore identity through layered, expressive portraiture. Students develop drawing, collage, and mixed media skills as they combine imagery, materials, and symbolism to create a personal final piece. We focus on experimentation, composition, and building a strong, meaningful outcome supported by GCSE-style research and annotation.



Arts Award

Bronze Arts Award Units 1 & 2

A creative introduction to Bronze Arts Award where learners design their own Fantasy Bedroom project, explore an art form in depth, and complete fun arts reviews. They build research, reflection and communication skills while keeping an arts log and developing confidence as young artists beginning their Bronze journey.



Explore Arts Award Units 1 & 2a

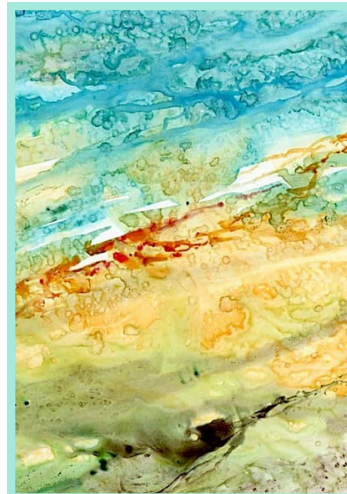
A playful introduction to Explore Arts Award where learners complete the Inside & Outside Me project, create a bold Big Mouth artwork, and discover Henri Rousseau to make their own colourful jungle scene. Along the way they build creative skills, research confidence and reflection as they record their journey in an arts log.



Art All Levels

Watercolour Watercolour Alchemy

Explore creative and expressive approaches to watercolour through playful techniques and experimentation. Students build confidence with colour, layering, and mark-making while trying methods such as wet-on-wet, texture, and mixed media. We focus on exploration, creativity, and developing a personal style through vibrant, imaginative work.



Inspire

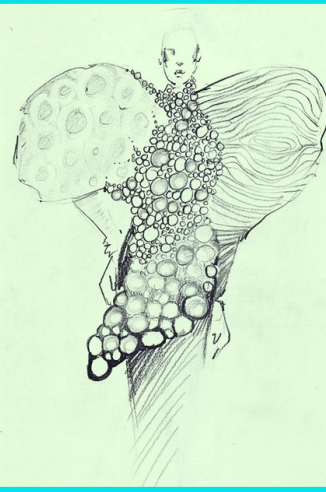
Explore a range of artists and styles each week, including Mr Phil, Joan Miró, Margaret Keane, Arcimboldo, Minhau, and Chris Ofili. Students experiment with different techniques and ideas, building confidence, creativity, and personal style through fun, expressive projects inspired by each artist.



Fashion Illustration

Wearable & Avant-Garde

Explore the contrast between everyday wearable fashion and bold, experimental avant-garde design. Students **develop fashion illustration skills while designing creative outfits inspired by both practical and imaginative concepts.** We focus on silhouette, materials, and pushing ideas to create unique and expressive fashion pieces.



Draw

Mythical Creatures

Build drawing confidence through imaginative studies of mythical creatures, from dragons to hybrid beasts. Students develop skills in shape, proportion, line, and shading while exploring creativity and character design. We focus on observation, imagination, and bringing original creatures to life through expressive drawing.
