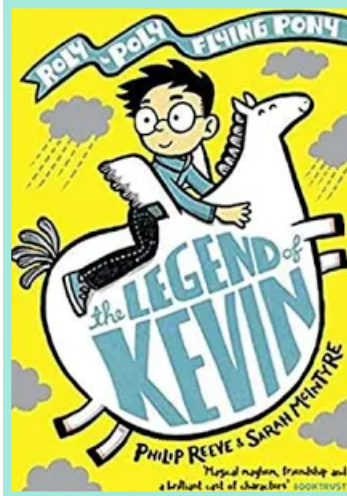

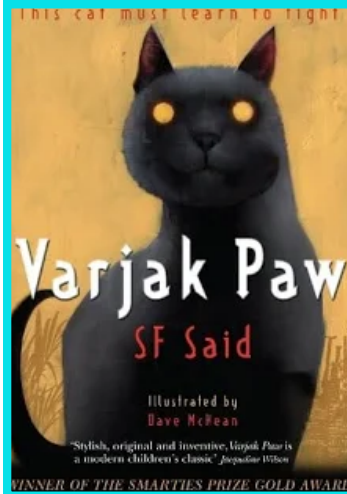

Varjak Paw by SF Said

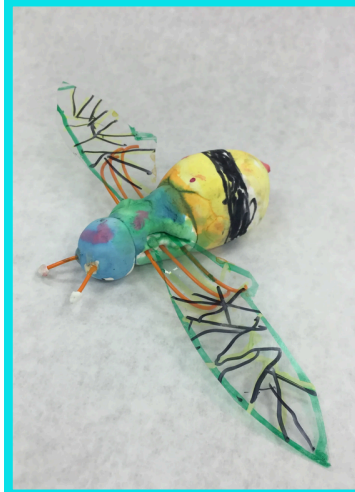

Megacities and the future

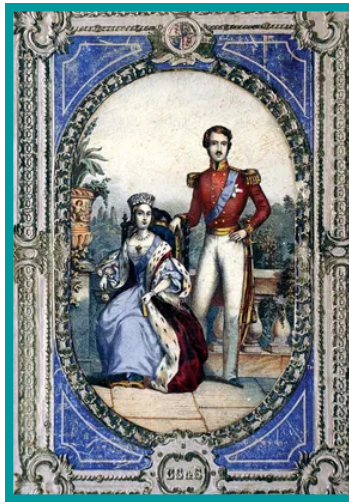

Ages 9-13

History **The Victorians**

Step into the fascinating world of the **Victorians**, exploring everything from factories and inventions to crime, childhood and life in the British Empire. Learners build **historical enquiry, source analysis and critical thinking skills** through stories, artefacts and investigations into one of Britain's most transformative eras.



English **The Lie Tree** **Frances Hardinge**

Uncover mystery, secrets and science in The Lie Tree by Frances Hardinge, a gripping Gothic adventure set in Victorian England. Learners build **comprehension, inference and analytical writing skills** while exploring themes of truth, power and belief through discussion, close reading and creative responses.

Ages 11-14

Creative Writing

Develop your storytelling skills through exciting writing challenges exploring **twists, suspense, sensory detail, pacing and dramatic settings**. Learners build confidence with story structure, atmosphere and creative voice, experimenting with techniques such as cyclical stories, setting mash-ups and high-stakes situations. **New learners welcome — no previous Creative Writing classes needed.**



Art **Portraits & Identity**

Explore how artists use portraiture to express personality, emotion and identity through symbolic self-portraits inspired by Frida Kahlo and Jean-Michel Basquiat. Learners build confidence with **facial proportions, expressive mark-making, symbolism and mixed media** while creating a final portrait that tells their unique story.

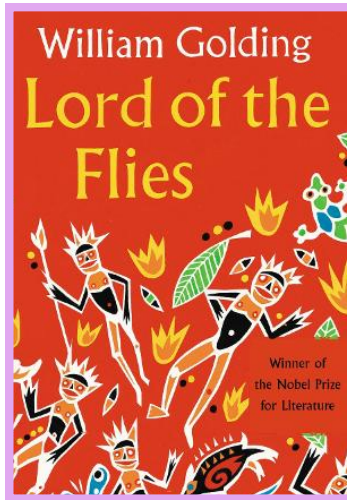


KS4/GCSE Ages 14-16

English

Lord of the Flies
William Golding

Explore William Golding's gripping novel Lord of the Flies, following a group of boys stranded on an island as order begins to break down. Learners build **analytical, essay writing and exam skills** while exploring themes of power, human nature, fear and civilisation through close reading and discussion.



Art

Time: A Personal Investigation

Develop an independent art project inspired by the theme of **time**, exploring personal ideas through artist research, mood boards, experimentation and annotation. Learners build confidence with **GCSE-style sketchbook development, media exploration and visual analysis**, creating a personal final outcome while learning how to develop ideas at a GCSE standard.

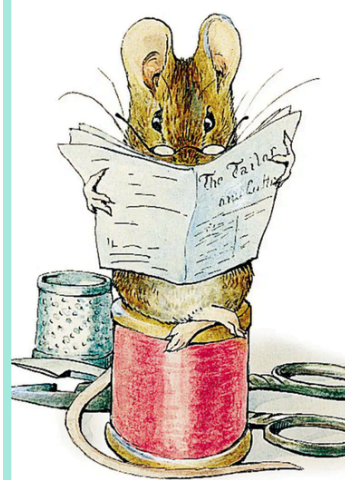


Art All Levels

Watercolour

Beatrix Potter's World

Step into the charming world of **Beatrix Potter** as learners paint beloved characters from Peter Rabbit, The Tailor of Gloucester and Miss Moppet. Building confidence with **watercolour techniques, observation and illustration skills**, learners explore soft washes, fine details and storybook composition inspired by Potter's timeless artwork.



Inspire

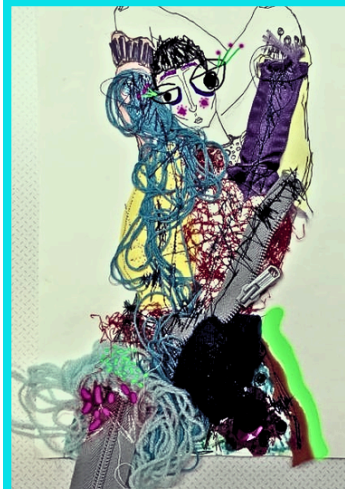

Learners experiment with **colour, pattern, mark-making and mixed media**, building confidence as they create artwork inspired by a wide range of artistic styles and ideas.



Fashion Illustration

Personal Style & Creative Remix

Develop your own fashion illustration style while remixing ideas from fashion history, fantasy, culture and wearable art. Learners build confidence with **texture, exaggeration, creative design and personal expression** to create original fashion concepts. **New learners welcome — no previous terms needed.**



Draw

Shells in Detail

Slow down and learn to really look as learners explore the shapes, textures and patterns of shells through detailed weekly drawings. Building confidence with **observation, shading, line work and texture**, learners create realistic shell studies while developing patience and drawing accuracy.
