

**The Magic Faraway Tree: Enid Blyton**



**Street Child: Berlie Doherty**



**Trade, Treasures and Thieves**


Journey from Atlantic trade routes to famous stolen treasures as we explore **historic trading networks, looted artefacts**, and **notorious pirates**. Learners build **history, geography and critical thinking skills** through timelines, maps, debates and creative tasks, uncovering who traded what, who stole what, and why these stories still matter today.



## **History**

### **Medieval England**

Explore the dramatic events that shaped the Middle Ages—from 1066 and the Norman Conquest to the Black Death, rebellions and royal power struggles. Learners develop **historical enquiry and source analysis skills** through timelines, artefacts and vivid stories that bring this turbulent era to life.





## **English**

### **The Book Thief**

**Markus Zusak**

Study this powerful story set in Nazi Germany over a full 12 weeks, exploring themes of **courage, loss and the power of words**. Learners develop **analysis, essay writing and critical reading skills** through close study of characters, narrative voice and historical context, bringing depth and confidence to their English work.



## **Creative Writing**

Unlock your imagination through weekly writing challenges that explore **character, setting, description and dialogue**. Learners **build confident writing voices, stronger vocabulary and storytelling skills** as they experiment with different genres—from suspense to fantasy to real-world drama. A supportive space to create, share ideas and develop crafty, compelling writing.



## **Art**

### **Colour & Emotion**

Explore how colour and brushwork express feelings as you experiment with **warm and cool palettes, expressive techniques and abstract composition**. Inspired by Kandinsky and Rothko, learners **build confidence with painting, personal expression and visual decision-making** while creating a bold abstract artwork that represents an emotion.




## KS4/GCSE Ages 14-16

### English

#### Pride and Prejudice: Jane Austen


Dive into Austen's world of wit, romance and social expectation while building **confident analysis, essay writing and exam-ready reading skills**. Over 12 weeks, learners explore **themes, context, character development and Austen's sharp narrative voice**, developing strong critical responses and a clear understanding of this classic GCSE text.



### Art

#### Drawing Mastery

Strengthen your drawing through focused work on **tone, proportion and expressive mark-making**, inspired by Leonardo da Vinci and Jenny Saville. Learners **build confident observational skills** using charcoal, ink and pencil, creating a detailed still life or expressive drawing series to showcase their technique.



### Sociology

Explore big questions about **identity, power and inequality** while discovering why people behave the way they do. Learners investigate **rules, opportunity, crime, deviance and social research**, building confidence through real-life case studies and discussion. A perfect foundation for anyone considering **GCSE Sociology**, or who simply loves understanding how society works.



### Bronze Arts Award

#### Units 1 & 2


A creative introduction to Bronze Arts Award where learners design their own **Fantasy Bedroom project**, explore an art form in depth, and complete fun **arts reviews**. They build research, reflection and communication skills while keeping an arts log and developing confidence as young artists beginning their Bronze journey.



### Explore Arts Award

#### Units 1 & 2a

A playful introduction to Explore Arts Award where learners complete the **Inside & Outside Me project**, create a bold **Big Mouth artwork**, and discover **Henri Rousseau** to make their own colourful jungle scene. Along the way they **build creative skills, research confidence and reflection** as they record their journey in an arts log.

# Art All Levels

## Watercolour Cityscapes and Skylines

Explore the atmosphere of the city through **sunset skies, rainy streets, glowing night scenes and iconic landmarks**. Learners build confidence with **gradients, pen-and-wash details, glazing, contrast and reflections**, creating expressive urban artworks from skylines to bridges over water.



## Inspire

Explore a new artist each week and try their techniques for yourself. This term includes **Caravaggio, Nick Cave, Wangechi Mutu, Sophie Green, Kittie Jones and Lora Zombie**, with projects ranging from chiaroscuro still life and surreal collage to wildlife painting, textured sensory art and bold pop-grunge ink work. A fun, creative class that builds **confidence, style exploration and expressive skills**.



## Fashion Illustration Fantasy and Sci-Fi Fashion

Design bold, imaginative outfits inspired by fantasy and futuristic worlds. Learners explore **mood boards, character design, unusual materials, dramatic silhouettes and environmental backdrops**, building skills in **concept art, proportion and creative thinking** as they develop their own original character and costume illustrations.



## Draw Under The Sea

Build drawing confidence through weekly underwater subjects, from **sea turtles and seahorses to submarines, coral scenes and whales**. Learners practise **shape, proportion, line work and shading** while creating fun, characterful drawings that explore the amazing world beneath the waves.
